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Acrylic Care and Maintenance

1) Cleaning Methods: Use only a very soft 100 % cotton flannel cloth when cleaning acrylic surfaces. It is possible to scratch acrylic, so NEVER use any scouring compounds or chemical cleaners such as Windex or other glass cleaners (even if they are environmentally friendly, organic or non-scented). Should anything ever stick to an acrylic surface (such as an adhesive label or tacky substance) do not use any type of solvent or commercial cleaner, use only water.

2) Avoid Scratching: Never use the same cloth that you clean other household items with – it can retain dirt, grit, and chemical residues that may harm your acrylic sheet. We recommend using a new or separate cloth for your acrylic care. Do not wear watches, rings, or bracelets when clean the surface. Long fingernails should be covered with gloves.

3) Acceptable Cleaning and Maintenance Materials: 100 % cotton flannel with fresh water.

4) Unacceptable Cleaning and Maintenance Materials:

- Paper towels or other paper products
- Shop towels or synthetic fiber fabrics
- Commercial window cleaners
- Any cleaning products
- Lighter fluids
- Petroleum based products can damage acrylic surface.
- Windex, Ajax
- Commercial acrylic polishing compounds as most contain solvents.
- **Any product containing ammonia or solvents or alcohol, plasticizers!**
